

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The Alpine refuge “Giossos Apostolidis” was built to serve the needs of mountaineers, climbers as well as any other visitor in Mountain Olympus.
2. The refuge doesn't serve as a place for entertainment but as a place for training on the upper summits of Mountain Olympus. Visitors, during their staying, are not allowed to act as they wish, but they shall comply with the rules and regulations as well as the indications of the refuge's manager.
3. Visitors are obliged to behave well and keep the premises of the refuge clean and tidy.
5. All mountaineers and visitors are obliged to check in and sign in the visitors' guest book.
6. Visitors who spend the night at the refuge, whether belonging to a group or individually, before their departure, are requested to ask from the manager a receipt which shows the day/days spent in the refuge.
7. Whoever uses the refuge, is required to protect the building and any other installation from destruction.
8. Whoever, under any circumstances, damages the building, furniture or appliances, should be fined.
9. Leaders and guides of mountaineering and excursion groups, should be in charge of the refuge's proper use during their staying and before their departure.
10. The refuge operates on a daily basis from July to September and is guarded by a refuge keeper-manager. During winter, people who are interested in having access to the refuge should contact the curator of the Club of Greek Mountaineers, in Thessaloniki (Tel. +30 2310224710).
11. The Alpine refuge provides sleep and food , and those who are interested should book in advance and pay a deposit (for further information contact the Club of Greek Mountaineers in Thessaloniki).
12. Compliance with these rules and regulations is left to the sensitivity and mountaineering consciousness of the visitors. The Board of the Mountaineering Club, however, reserves the right to take any measures which would contribute to the orderly functioning of the refuge.
13. For any complaints, including any improper service or finding, visitors and mountaineers of the Giossos Apostolidis refuge, are kindly requested to address to the Board of the Club of Greek Mountaineers in written notice (S.E.O. – 5 Aristotelous Str., 546 24 Thessaloniki) or, otherwise, notify the curator of the refuge or any other member of the Board.

The following shall be prohibited:

- Smoking at all premises of the Alpine refuge.
- Playing cards.
- Using Tape-Recorders and CD players.
- Having noisy events.

- Drinking to a degree of disturbance.
- Eating in the rooms, the lounge and the balcony of the 1st floor.
- Entering and staying in the kitchen.
- Making any noise from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Serving food or sleep services after 10.30 p.m.
